The Howard School Sport Partnership (HSSP) is a highly experienced group of PE specialists and sport staff (4). We are based in the local area of Medway where we work closely with our primary schools to deliver all the elements of our HSSP menu.

We are highly adaptable and flexible whilst striving to meet the needs of staff and pupils. Through good use of some of your Primary PE Premium ring fenced government funding, we can help your primary school to meet many of the 5 key indicators (required through your annual 'Evidencing the Impact Action Plan' to be posted on your website in July each year).

We endeavour to continuously improve our school sport services based on the feedback and survey responses of our community of primary schools.



Free of Charge Services

Central co-ordination and planning, meetings, equipment loan and School Games Award applications (Bronze/Silver/Gold and Platinum)

- Health and safety advice from a Secondary specialist: PE qualified Teacher (SSCo) via Assoc. for PE (AfPE) and occasional network meetings. Plus one-to-one meetings to help apply for national School Games Mark Award applications online, including the 5 School Games outcomes.
- Regular email updates: offering sports participation and coaching opportunities for your pupils from local community sports clubs/training for your staff and externally funded projects for those in socially deprived areas or targeted groups of pupils. Two newsletters and 1 annual report per year and HSSP website and X/Twitter account, plus co-ordination of Medway and HSSP inter-school sports event annual calendar and long term loan of some sports equipment and some PE Teaching resources/S.O.W.
- Advice and support on Government's School Sport and Activity Action plan and strategy for tackling childhood obesity, as well as the Sport England 'Uniting the Movement Strategy' to help implement the daily Active 30 outcome (30 mins of daily physical activity for every child at school) and help to improve young people's physical, mental and social well-being and help to address pupil inequalities in PE/School Sport.
- Central advice and support to Head Teachers and PE Co-ordinators on how to draft and update their Evidencing the Impact action plan in July annually. To be posted on primary school websites on how the PE Premium funding has had a positive impact on pupils and staff, under the 5 key indicator areas:

Key indicator 1:

The engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity - Chief Medical Officers guidelines recommend that primary school pupils undertake at least 30 minutes of physical activity a day in school

Key indicator 2:

The profile of PESSPA (Physical Education School Sport and Physical Activity) being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement

Key indicator 3:

Increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport

Key indicator 4:

Broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils

Key indicator 5:

Increased participation in competitive sport

Bronze Package

For Primary and Infant Schools

B1. Young Leaders and School Sports Crew (SSOC) training programme

- 1x Young Leaders training for a maximum of 16 Year 5&6 pupils. Delivered at your school by our staff over 5 hours (max) - certificates are included. Trained Young Leaders are deployed on playground at lunchtime to deliver activities and games for younger pupils. Young leaders can also help School Sports Organising Crew members to deliver intra-school competitions/other after-school clubs and physical activities across your school year.
- 1x School Sports Organising Crew training (2-3 hours centrally OR delivered by your HSSP staff member at your school) for 8 selected pupils (2x sport captains, 2x sport designers, 2x statisticians and 2x sport reporters). Crew/Young Leaders to be deployed to assist staff to deliver School Games intra-school sports competitions at your school.

B2. Friendly competitive matches

- Friendly competitive matches after-school for Years 5/6. Schools are able to bring A, B and C teams to practice sessions for MYG (e.g. netball). This is designed to help prepare children for the Mini Youth Games (MYG) and provide an opportunity to bring more than one team.

B3. Unlimited School Games Festivals/Competitions with 'Me Outcomes'

- Entry into any number of Howard SSP/Medway Primary School Games events (inter-school competitions/festivals, not including Mini Youth Games - MYG) per year.
- Admin. costs (sports facility hire, medals/prizes, additional staff and umpires costs) for 12-14 Festivals with 'Me Outcomes', organised by HSSP (mainly for Y1-4). Tri Golf Festival x 2 (Y1&2 and Y3&4), Multi-Skills Festival x 2 (Y1&2 and Y3&4), Balance Bikes (Y1-2), Sports Hall Athletics x 2 (both Y3&4 and Y5&6), Racket Skills Festival (Y3&4), Medway Quick Sticks Hockey (Y3&4), Medway Girls Football & Dynamos Cricket Festival (Y5&6), Infant Games/Active Health Festival (Y1&2) and HSSP Dance Festival (Y1 upwards), plus 1/2 targeted festivals for under-represented pupils.

Silver Package

For Primary and Infant Schools

Includes all of the BRONZE school sport package (B1, B2 and B3) plus:

- Access to your HSSP member of staff to deliver a 30 mins 'Mental Health and Physical Activity Road-show' to one targeted class (from Years 1-6) - just before delivering the Young Leaders Playground training for the day i.e. the same day.
- A 'pupil voice' training session delivered by our staff for your leaders, teaching them how to consult with and survey pupils in the playground to gain feedback on: Active 30 i.e how physically active are your pupils every day at school, what they like/dislike about PE/physical activity and school sport and what type of activities they might like to take part in the future at school. This helps provide survey evidence for your PE subject lead teacher, Ofsted, and for your School Games Mark Award evidence for verification visit.
- PE CPD annual programme of workshops - annual programme of twilight and day courses. For example gymnastics, dance, swimming, invasion games, multi-skills, SEN PE, Yoga and mental health, OAA, Orienteering and other sports workshops. Accessible to any number of primary teaching staff from your school, when your school is signed up to the HSSP Silver Package 2024-25. (There is a limit of 2 members of staff per primary school to attend the annual Swim England course we offer as part of the CPD programme).

Gold Package

For Primary and Infant Schools

Includes all of the BRONZE school sport package (B1, B2, B3 and B4) plus:

- Access to your HSSP member of staff to deliver a 30 mins 'Mental Health and Physical Activity Road-show' to one targeted class (from Years 1-6) - just before delivering the Young Leaders Playground training for the day i.e. the same day.
- Active Health Ambassadors training for half a day and 8 pupils who wish to help their teachers to raise the profile of Health projects and lead a campaign in school. Active Health Ambassadors to mentor younger pupils to encourage them to become more physically active/change eating and drinking habits.
- Lunchtime supervisors training on playground games and young leader deployment, 1-2 hours training by HSSP staff to enable them to be confident in a wider range of playground games by deploying and organising young leaders, resulting in the playground becoming more structured for pupils and helping to reduce the number of incidents and behavioural problems at lunchtime.
- A 'pupil voice' training session delivered by our staff for your leaders, teaching them how to consult with and survey pupils in the playground to gain feedback on: Active 30 i.e how physically active are your pupils every day at school, what they like/dislike about PE/physical activity and school sport and what type of activities they might like to take part in the future at school. This helps provide survey evidence for your PE subject lead teacher, Ofsted, and for your School Games Mark Award evidence for verification visit.

Other individually priced school sports services

Sports Coaching

£330

Minimum 4 (maximum 5) weeks of a one hour session after-school sports club for pupils with qualified sports coach OR 4/5 x 1 hour sports coaching sessions, working alongside a Primary Teacher/TA to learn from the Coach. Ideally after school/before school.

School Sport Organising Crew (SSOC) training (half day)

£190

School Sport Organising Crew training for half a day (for 8 selected pupils: 2x sports captains, 2x sports designers, 2x statisticians and 2x reporters). To be deployed to assist your PE Co-ordinator/staff to deliver intra-school sports competitions at your school, assist with Health projects/assemblies (e.g. Daily Mile) or other suitable physical activity projects.

Young Leaders training (5 hours) | Mini Leaders Training (2 x 1 hours)

£425 | £250

5-hours training for Young Leaders (playground or other form of sport leadership training). Certificates will be given to successful pupils from Years 5/6. Year 2 Mini leaders training is available. Specifically designed for Year 2 - a very basic leadership introduction so that pupils can help to deliver playground games and activities during lunchtimes.

Active Health Ambassadors training

£250

A half-day session for 8 pupils to train as Active Health Ambassadors. Active Health Ambassadors will help their teachers to raise the profile of health projects and a campaign in school. They will mentor younger pupils to encourage them to become more physically active, as well as change their eating and drinking habits.

Howard SSP Primary PE Assessment tool

£500 KS1 & 2 | £400 KS2 | £300 KS1

Memory-stick to help Primary Teachers track their pupil's progress, in all areas of the PE curriculum. This is an in-depth excel tool that can be used to help plan lessons, identify where pupils are at in their PE learning, identify who is/is not making progress, and providing evidence to feedback to pupils, parents, line managers and Ofsted.



Sports Day

£900

1 Sports Day at your primary school (one day planning and another day to assist delivery). The HSSP member of staff will bring in student sport leaders to assist where possible.

Wake and Shake staff training

£660

Training by a HSSP member of staff and the loan of resources to encourage 10 mins of daily physical exercise (towards the 30 mins of daily physical activity target) for all pupils at your school, in the classroom. To help promote pupil's concentration/focus and readiness for classroom lessons.

Health project at Medway Park (1 class of 30 only, for 6 x 1 hour sessions)

£2700

1 class (maximum 30 Year 5/6 children) to participate in 6 x 1 hour health and fitness sessions led by qualified fitness instructors, at Medway Park Shokk Gym. Class must be supervised by 2 teachers/TAs. Includes 30 pupil log books, certificates and occasional fruit for pupils. THIS DOES NOT INCLUDE TRANSPORTATION TO AND FROM MEDWAY PARK.

Lunchtime supervisors training on playground games and young leader deployment

£280

1-2 hours training by HSSP staff for lunchtime supervisors, to enable them to be more confident in a wider range of playground games and the deployment and organisation of trained Young Leaders. Resulting in the playground becoming more structured for pupils and helping to reduce the number of incidents and behavioural problems at lunchtime.

CPD programme of courses 2024-2025

£80 per delegate per course (excl. Swim England course)

or

£700 for whole school to attend any number of workshops

The HSSP CPD programme of twilight courses 2024-2025 might include gymnastics, dance, swimming, invasion games, SEN PE multi-skills, OAA, Orienteering and Yoga/Active Maths and English lessons workshop. Any primary school staff member/whole school can attend any number of HSSP workshops (excluding Swim England 3 day course). Bookings accepted on a 'first come first served' basis.

Intra-School Sports Competition

£900

Member of HSSP staff to deliver an Intra-School Sports competition in a day - with assistance from the Primary PE Subject Leader, young leaders and SSOCs. A range of activities can be offered. (9 hours including planning)

Unlimited Competitions/Festivals for the academic year

£870 (admin costs)

Enter an unlimited number of Medway Primary School Games/HSSP organised Inter-School Sports Festivals (and HSSP friendly fixtures) in this academic year from the following: Tri Golf (Y1&2 and Y3&4), Multi-Skills (Y1&2 and Y3&4), Balance Bikes (YR/1-2), Sports Hall Athletics (Y3&4 and Y5&6), Racket Skills Festival (Y3&4) Medway Quick Sticks Hockey (Y3&4) Girls Football and Kwik Cricket (Y5&6) Infant Games/Active Lives Festival (Y1&2) and HSSP Dance Festival (Y1-13).

One off Festival/Competition school team entry to one Festival

£80

Enter one Festival/Competition from the calendar: Medway Primary School Games/HSSP organised Inter-School Sports Festivals (and HSSP friendly fixtures) with 'Me Outcomes' 2024-25. Admin costs of £80 per school team entry.

International Sports Performer/VIP school visit

£2800 (whole day) | £1850 (half day)

Secure an international Sports Performer/VIP for a whole day at your school - to help inspire pupils to take up sport/healthy lifestyle and learn about athlete's achievements, work ethic and resilience.

Bespoke staff PE INSET training

£700 (whole day) | £495 (half day) | £275 (twilight period - 1.5hrs)

A specialist PE tutor delivers a PE training course (including resources) appropriate for your staff as part of your school INSET. This can be for a whole day/half day or 1.5 hours after school. We will do our best to find a member of staff or suitable external tutor to deliver this request on a date and time suitable to your school staff members. This would be in addition to the annual HSSP CPD programme of courses and open to your school teaching staff only. We can discuss a different price if you wish to deliver INSET across several primary schools altogether i.e a Trust. We can also deliver INSET as part of a staff team building training session to fit your Trust staff needs.

Provision of a specialist PE Teacher to team teach

£900 (6 x 1hr/45min) | £1100 (12 x 1hr/45min - 2 lessons back to back) |

£1000 (6 x 1.5hr) | £1160 (12 x 1.5hr - 2 lessons back to back)

(this can include an after-school sports club, if convenient on the same day - 45 mins-1 hour max)

Team teaching for a block of 6 weeks (1 term) should be alongside your staff member. This will support staff and help them to learn how to develop skills in a series of PE lessons, increase teacher confidence whilst demonstrating differentiation, progressions and challenging PE lessons for all abilities. It will also assist the teacher to assess pupil's progress in PE. All of this supportive team teaching would be delivered through a HSSP PE specialist and experienced PE Teacher.

After-School Sports Club for 4-5 weeks (on the same afternoon as the team teaching) can be included if convenient. Week one will allow you to promote the club to pupils before the HSSP member of staff delivers the sports club. This can be alongside a member of your staff or on their own and with a maximum of 15-20 pupils, depending upon the sport selected and the school space available.

(NEW) Provision of a specialist PE Co-ordinator for one day per week at your primary school for the whole academic year

This specialist could:

- Deliver PE curriculum lessons/team teach with your classroom teachers to upskill them
- Deliver staff PE INSET
- Organise after-school clubs
- Help organise trips/administration for other school staff to transport teams to festivals/fixtures off site (includes entry fees into Festivals)
- Help deliver intra-school events/school sports day
- Oversee the whole school being physically active every day: Active 30 such as the daily mile, active classroom lessons, playground activities and leadership training etc.
- Help with pupil voice and parent voice in PE and School Sport at your school and raise the profile of PE School Sport and Physical Activity across the whole school in order to improve pupil's physical, mental and social health. Record evidence for School Games Mark Award application and 5 school games outcomes
- Includes other HSSP school sport services as required i.e to fit into that one day per week

One day per week PE Co-ordinator/PE subject leader jointly line managed by both your Head Teacher and with support from the HSSP throughout the academic year.

(NEW) Targeted and 'have a go' themed Sports Festival at your primary school for half a day for targeted pupils i.e. those that do not normally enjoy taking part in PE/School Sport activities/SEN/younger/less able pupils

Our member of HSSP staff can plan and deliver a 'have a go' fun activity Festival for half a day in your school, to engage a small number of targeted pupils i.e. SEN/Girls/BAME pupils that are 'in the most need' as identified by your classroom teachers/SENCO. We would welcome the help of the PE Subject Leader and SENCO and possibly young leaders from your school. This will help to provide evidence for your school games outcome number 2 (delivering and engaging in competitions that have clear intent and creates positive experiences based on the motivation, competence and confidence of your young people that need support most) which would help to gain evidence for your school games mark award application.
